CONTRACT OF UNDERSTANDING

I, _____, apply for membership in the United States Naval Sea Cadet Corps. I understand my responsibilities are as follows:

1. To attend at least 80% of all drills and activities to maintain membership in this Unit. If I am required to miss a drill, or other activity, I understand the Unit requires that I contact the Leading Petty Officer (LPO) or the Executive Officer (XO). This will be done at least twenty four hours in advance of the activity. Three consecutive unexcused absences will result in my dismissal.
2. I am responsible for my appearance, and upkeep of my appearance and uniforms, and I also realize the importance of maintaining a proper appearance in or out of uniform. I am also responsible to bring all required uniforms to every drill. In addition I will abide by all current U.S. Navy uniform and grooming regulations and standards. Failure to do so will result in my dismissal from the Corps.
3. Education is a major part of a Cadet's life. I understand I must maintain a minimum 2.5 grade point average to remain in the Corps I must bring my report card each semester for verification. Furthermore, I understand that academic requirements will be placed on me for (Naval Sea Cadet /Navy League Cadet) advancements and that I must advance, or attempt to advance, whenever eligible. I also understand I must attend Boot Camp (Recruit Training) during my first summer or winter break in the Sea Cadet or Navy League Cadet program, and perform at least one annual two week training, of my choice, each year thereafter. Failure to adhere to the above is cause for dismissal.
4. I will renew my registration at least thirty (30) days in advance of the expiration date.

1. I, _____, being the parent/guardian of the above, accept the material issued to my son/daughter/ward with the full understanding that they are the property of the Training Ship Ronald Reagan/Ronald Reagan Division of the United States Naval Sea Cadet Corps. The uniforms are entrusted to me while my son/daughter/ward is a member of the Unit. In the event of loss or damage or abuse of any or all of the uniforms issued I am liable for the replacement of each said article in kind.

2. I understand that the enrollment fee is \$150.00 of which \$60.00 is nonrefundable. After thirty (30) days should my Cadet withdraw from the program the full enrollment fee becomes nonrefundable. Subsequent monthly dues will be \$30.00 per month, payable in advance. This amount is subject to increase but all dues for the total Unit membership will be affected not just any one individual's.

3. Should any financial problem arise it is your responsibility to notify the Commanding or Executive Officer. A limited number of scholarships are available. These are issued on a case by case basis. All conversations will be held in the strictest confidence. We want the young people to be able to participate in the program regardless of income.

4. While the Ronald Reagan Division attempts to issue all uniforms, I understand that not all items are always available through the Naval Sea Cadet Corps supply channels. I further understand that those items not available that are required by the Corps and Division for my son/daughter/ward to be incomplete uniform must be acquired by me.

5. I will be responsible for returning any and all uniforms, books, and equipment issued to my son/daughter/ward at the termination of their enrollment in the Sea Cadet/Navy League Cadet programs. If those items are not returned then I will replace them in kind or pay their value. Failure to return Unit property will result in a letter of indebtedness being forwarded to the Navy Legal Services office. Furthermore, should I purchase any items the Unit may purchase them at a fair market value providing they are in good condition at that time.
